



SAINT PETERSBURG STADIUM

- 🛠 Was built in 2017 upon the project of the architect Kisho Kurokawa.
- Staged the matches of 2017 FIFA Confederations Cup and 2018 FIFA World Cup, UEFA Champions League, the Russian Premier League, and the Russian Cup.
- The home stadium of Zenit Football Club.
- Arena capacity 61,000 (30,500 spectators with consideration to a 50% restriction).
- 🛠 Is to stage 2022 UEFA Champions League Final.
- During 2020 EURO, the Media Centre will operate at the stadium for journalists accredited by UEFA. Working hours:

How to get: 1 Futbolnaya Alley

During EURO, Zenit metro station will be open, which is within the walking distance from the arena. Another option is Krestovsky Island metro station; walk about 2 km along the central alley of Maritime Victory Park to get to the stadium.

During EURO, there will be three big screen locations available in Saint Petersburg for screenings and having fun with your family and friends:

- Football Village on Konyushennaya Square. Public screening of all matches.
 11 June 11 July (closed on 25 and 30 June);
 working hours: 12:00 00:00 (01:00 if match kicks-off at 22:00)
 How to get: 1. Konyushennaya Square (Nevsky Avenue is the nearest metro station).
- Public viewing area on Palace Square (working days: 2, 3, 6, 7, and 11 July) How to get: Palace Square (Nevsky Avenue, Gostiny Dvor, Admiralteyskaya are the nearest metro stations).

 Football Park by Yubileyny Sports Palace working hours: Weekdays: 12:00 – 20:00,
 Saturday-Sunday: 10:00 – 21:00.

If match kicks-off at 10 pm, Park closes 15 minutes prior to the final whistle (23:45) **How to get:** (18 Dobrolyubova Avenue; **Sportivnaya** is the nearest metro station).





UNIQUE PROJECTS of EURO 2020



CELEBRITIES We Expect to Come to Saint Petersburg

Team of Russia: Artem Dzyuba

A striker of Zenit — the leader, captain, and top scorer of the present team. By the EURO start, Artem narrowed big-time Alexander Kerzhakov's goal scoring record for the national team (29 for Dzyuba against 30 for Kerzhakov).





Team of Finland: Teemu Pukki

Pukki had always been considered a talented striker, and after his transfer to Norwich City in 2018, he seemed to have found his second wind. Teemu's qualification goal scores were most helpful to the Finns at the qualification and finally brought them to the EURO for the first time.

Team of Belgium: Kevin de Bruyne

Kevin confirmed his high football skills by scoring four and assisting for seven goals in six qualification games. In English Premier League and Champions League, de Bruyne has been one of the consistent leaders of Manchester City. He is arriving in Saint Petersburg having a status of an important tournament star.







CELEBRITIES We Expect to Come to Saint Petersburg



Team of Slovakia: Marek Hamšík

The top scorer and the heart of the national team who is the record-holder by matches played for Slovakia national. Energetic and tireless, a 33-year player is yet the main driving force of the team. It is hard to even think of the Slovak team without him.

Team of Sweden: Emil Forsberg

The missing of Zlatan Ibrahimovic has certainly made the Swedish team a little less attractive. But there are plenty of strong players in the team: after all, the team has done without Ibra in recent years. One of the Swedish leaders is Emil Forsberg. The half-back is approaching the Euros at the perfect age and after a great season at RB Leipzig. He is no stranger to being the leader at important moments.






Team of Poland: Robert Lewandowski


